Living Independent ForEver (LIFE) Program Program Requirements

- 1 Program Participant must abide by the structure of the LIFE Program.
- 2 Goals and program objectives will be established according to your desired personal growth to empower you to live independently.
- 3 No visitors are allowed on property without consent of program staff.
- 4 You are required to keep the monthly program fee current. A program fee is charged: \$350 is charged for sharing a 2-bedroom unit and only \$400 for 1-bedroom unit. The fee includes payment for electricity, water, and heat. Fees are due by the 1st of each month.
- 5 Full participation in monthly group meetings and program activities is mandatory.
- A Security deposit of \$100 is required at move-in. A payment arrangement can be made with the Program Administrator if you're not able to pay.
- If you are not employed, attending school or in a job training program, you must be in compliance with your Goal Plan developed with your Program Coordinator.
- 8 You are expected to actively work towards goals and complete personal growth modules assigned. The LIFE Program is designed to teach you healthy, responsible, and independent living skills which will enable you to transition into living independently.
- 9 You must refrain from any drug use, possession of drugs and drug paraphernalia on program property. LIFE program has a zero tolerance for alcohol and drug use.
- 10 Open criminal cases are not permitted during the application or residency.
- 11 Persons with a conviction of a crime against persons is not permitted in the program.
- 12 Honesty and integrity are always expected.
- 13 There will be zero tolerance of violence, physical or verbal abuse of staff or others. Abusive, disrespectful, or non-compliant behavior will result in your immediate withdrawal from the program.
- 14 The LIFE program is a coed program, but coed unit sharing is not permitted. Inner program relationships between participants are prohibited.
- 15 Participants are encouraged to participate in community volunteering events that take place throughout the year. Giving back is a civic responsibility and a strong part of our mission.
- 16 You will be required to keep belongings at a minimum level.
- 17 You cannot operate a business from your apartment that requires outside guests or visitors.
