Shiloh Community Housing, Inc. (SCHI) Mission

SCHI's mission is to remove the barriers to safe, affordable housing such as age, income, sustainable employment; lack of education or under-educated; and training/skills all which could prevent a person from ever obtaining personal sustainability and acquiring permanent housing.

Affordable Housing projects in Fairview and Mountainview; 1st project 2001; latest project also provides supportive services called Fresh Beginning in 2023

Living Independent Forever (LIFE) is a transitional housing program for young adults experiencing homelessness.

Workforce development to remove barriers to employment for young adults (who may also be homeless) LIFE AT Work (LIFE@Work)

Financial Assistance for at-risk community residents that are housed or seeking housing

The Furniture Bank provides individuals and families with home essentials

Resource Center - provides a one-stop-shop for services that will disrupt the cycle of homelessness, i.e., prevent homelessness

The DOL has agreed to operate a job center on site. Others that provide job and career education will also be onsite.



Financial Wellness training to promote financial literacy.



Parents and childcare providers will be allowed to leave their child or children in the drop-in childcare area of the facility while they are receiving services at the CRC.



The CRC commercial/community kitchen will be used for culinary arts training, kitchen safety for latchkey kids, etc. The kitchen will be community focused.



Several offices will be available for long-term lease and for short term lease by the hour.



We will collect donated gently used furniture and it will be given away for Free.
